FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR & BOARD CHAIR

Thanks to the creativity and resolve of staff, board, and volunteers, Historic Oakland Foundation (HOF) embraced the “new normal” of the continuing COVID-19 pandemic in 2021 and found new ways to preserve and enhance Oakland Cemetery and share it with visitors.

Reinstating HOF’s walking tours, signature special events, and other programs meant restarting the flow of much-needed revenue to invest into Oakland Cemetery’s restoration and care. Whether at *Sunday in the Park* or *Capturing the Spirit of Oakland*, in the Praise House created by Charmaine Minniefield, or on one of our many walking tours, thousands of Oakland visitors learned about the past, how it has shaped the present, and how it continues to shape the way we think about the world.

As HOF grows, we are increasingly able to beat back the ravages of time and mother nature and to care for historic material that is in desperate need of attention. On Oakland’s East Hill, we spent more than a

million dollars in 2021 fixing walls and walkways, resetting headstones and monuments, installing new, historically sensitive gardens, and adding new signage and amenities. As this area is being restored to its former glory, its stories are being added to our interpretive programming.


At the end of 2021, we were proud to announce publicly the *Living History* Capital Campaign. This \$12.5 million campaign will allow us to build a new Visitors Center outside the Cemetery’s main gate, rehabilitate the Bell Tower into a flexible programmatic space, and conduct the single largest preservation project in HOF history: six acres of Oakland’s East Hill.

All of this progress is made possible by donors, members, volunteers, and visitors who value historic Oakland Cemetery and its unique and special role in our city. We look forward to sharing our progress with you as we make the single largest investment ever at Oakland. Thank you for your continued support.

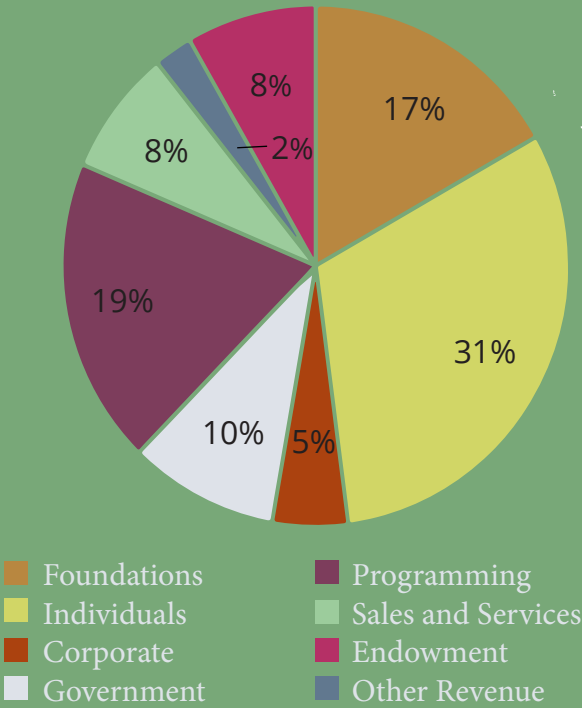

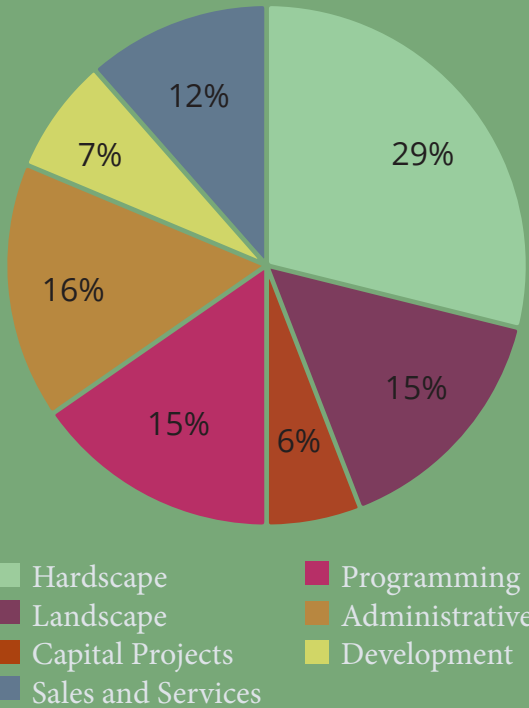

2021 FOUNDATION HIGHLIGHTS

LIVING HISTORY

On November 30, 2021, Historic Oakland Foundation announced its first-ever capital campaign, *Living History*, to raise \$12.5 million to rehabilitate the 1899 Oakland Bell Tower, build a new Visitors Center outside the Cemetery's main gate, and conduct the largest restoration project in HOF's history on the East Hill.

REMEMBRANCE AS RESISTANCE

In honor of Juneteenth 2021, the Remembrance as Resistance project was launched with the construction of a Praise House in Oakland Cemetery's historic African American Burial Grounds, which was visited by over 2,400 visitors. This project marked the completion of a three-year partnership with Flux Projects and artist and curator Charmaine Minnifield.

RESTORATION SUCCESS: THE EAST HILL

Significant progress was made on the East Hill restoration project, with all of the walkways on the East Hill repaired or restored, dozens of retaining walls rebuilt, hundreds of headstones preserved and reset, new irrigation installed throughout, and large-scale gardening beginning in the southeast section of the East Hill following the completion of hardscape restoration.

PROGRAMMING SUCCESS: SUNDAY IN THE PARK FT. TUNES FROM THE TOMBS

Breathing new life into two long-standing HOF events, September 2021 marked the merger of *Sunday in the Park* and *Tunes from the Tombs* to create one larger fall festival. Nearly 3000 visitors celebrated Atlanta's history while honoring the Victorian tradition of enjoying life while communing with the dead.

PROGRAMMING SUCCESS: CAPTURING THE SPIRIT OF OAKLAND®

To honor deferred tickets from 2020 and provide expanded access to Capturing the Spirit of Oakland after the event's cancellation in 2020, HOF welcomed over 12,000 visitors to Oakland Cemetery over three weekends in October 2021.

EXPANDING OUR DIVERSITY, INCLUSION, ACCESS, & EQUITY WORK

HOF was awarded a three-year, \$116,000 grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Services to build on the work we began in 2019 to fund and strengthen our organization's internal and external work and make HOF a more inclusive, accessible, equitable, and diverse organization.

BELL TOWER GROUNDBREAKING

On November 30, 2021, Mayor Keisha Lance Bottoms gathered at Oakland with Mrs. Mary Ellen Imlay, chairman and president of the Imlay Foundation; Dr. Eloisa Klementich, CEO of Invest Atlanta; Commissioner John Dargle of the Department of Parks and Recreation; and other dignitaries for a ceremonial groundbreaking for the rehabilitation of the Oakland Bell Tower.

AWARD OF EXCELLENCE: EAST GATE

The recently installed East Gate at the corner of Memorial Drive and Boulevard was recognized in 2021 with an Award of Excellence by the Atlanta Urban Design Commission.

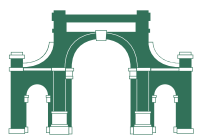
